### **Offer Feedback Now**

If you want to offer your feedback, but you're feeling overwhelmed or can only offer a short amount of time, use these suggestions to engage with the goals that make the most sense for the role you play in farm to school:

- **Producers:** If you are a farmer, rancher, food producer, food distributor, or food hub please focus on goals and strategies for Market Development, and then if you have additional time, review Food Education and Leadership Development.
- **Nutrition Services:** If you are a sponsor, director or staff of a Child Nutrition Program (NSLP, CACFP, SFSP) please start with the goals and strategies for **Food Access**, and then if you have time, review School Food Culture and Leadership Development.
- **Educators:** If you are a classroom teacher, informal educator, school garden volunteer or someone engaged in food and agriculture education please start with the goals and strategies for **Food Education**, and then if you have time, review School Food Culture and Leadership Development.
- **Youth and Families:** If you are a student, family member or caregiver of a student, please start with the goals and strategies for **School Food Culture** then if you have time, review Food Education and Food Access.
- **Support Organizations:** If you are part of a state agency or non-profit support organization, please select the goal to review based on the stakeholders you serve.

If you identify as BIPOC, a producer or work in early childhood education we may have funding to support your time. Honoraria of up to \$500 are available on a first come first serve basis.
